Disappearing Trades

Take a step back in time on this nostalgic journey where visitors can learn how bread was made the traditional way at one of the remaining traditional bakeries. Observe how the Chinese pray and pay their respects to their ancestors as they burn paper objects as a form of offering to the afterlife from one of the masters of paper houses. Coffee lovers will learn the tricks of the local kopi (coffee) industry, such as the roasting techniques, and they get to sample an aromatic cup of kopi 'O' (black coffee) at the end of the tour.

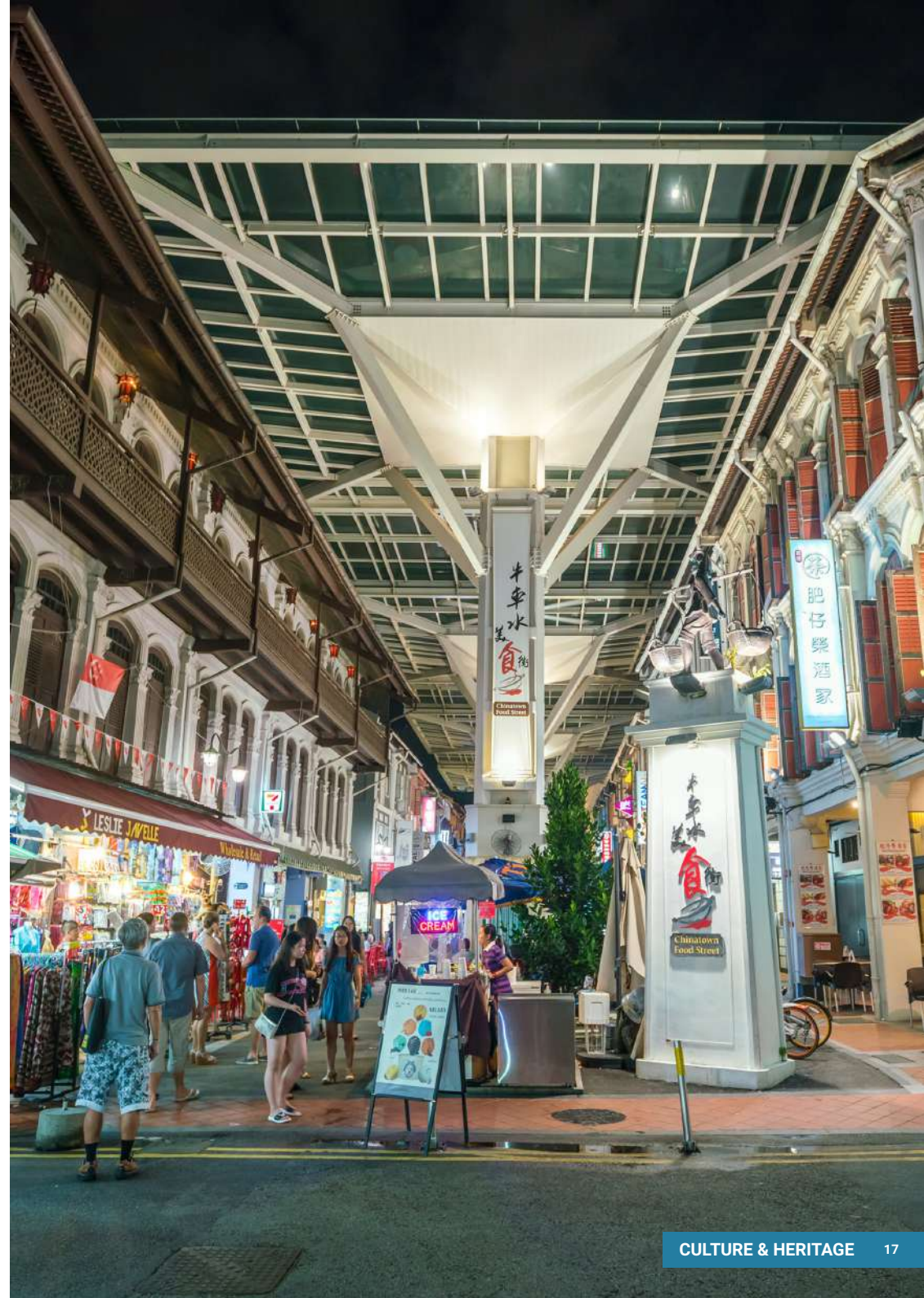

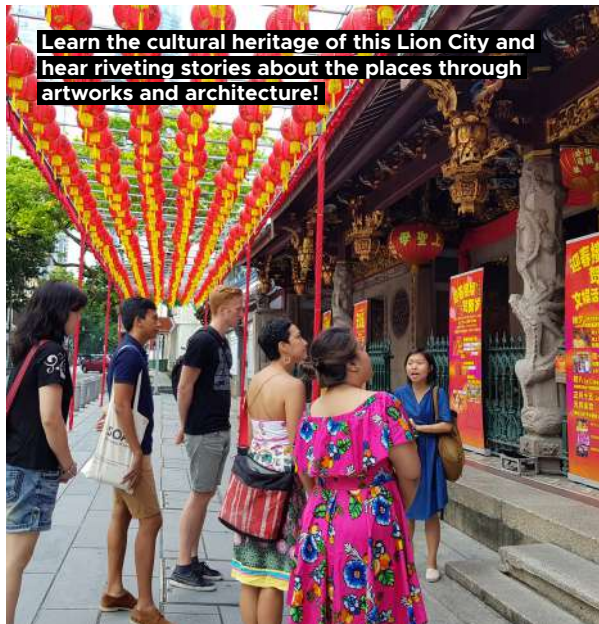

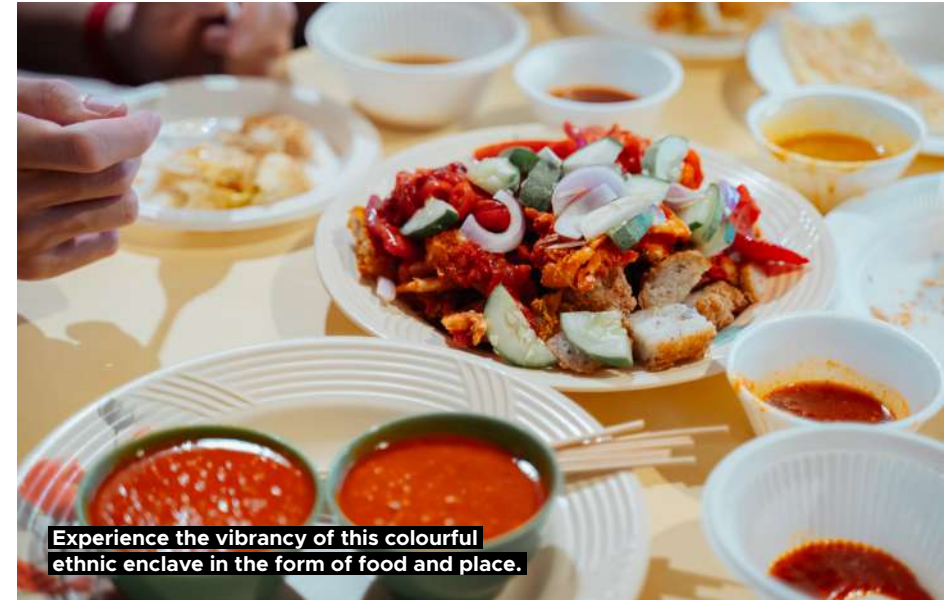

Considered Singapore's largest architecture conservation district, the Joo Chiat and Katong area is not only a treasure trove for delectable local food but is also known for its decorative and ornate shophouses and residential terraces, lending the place a unique charm. During the 1920s and 1930s, many communities built housings, shophouses and places of worship in this area, a reflection of a multi-cultural and varied community of Peranakan, Eurasian, Malay, Chinese and Indian cultures.

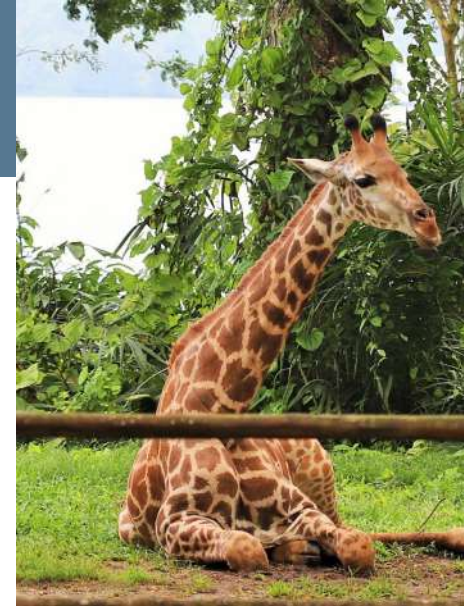

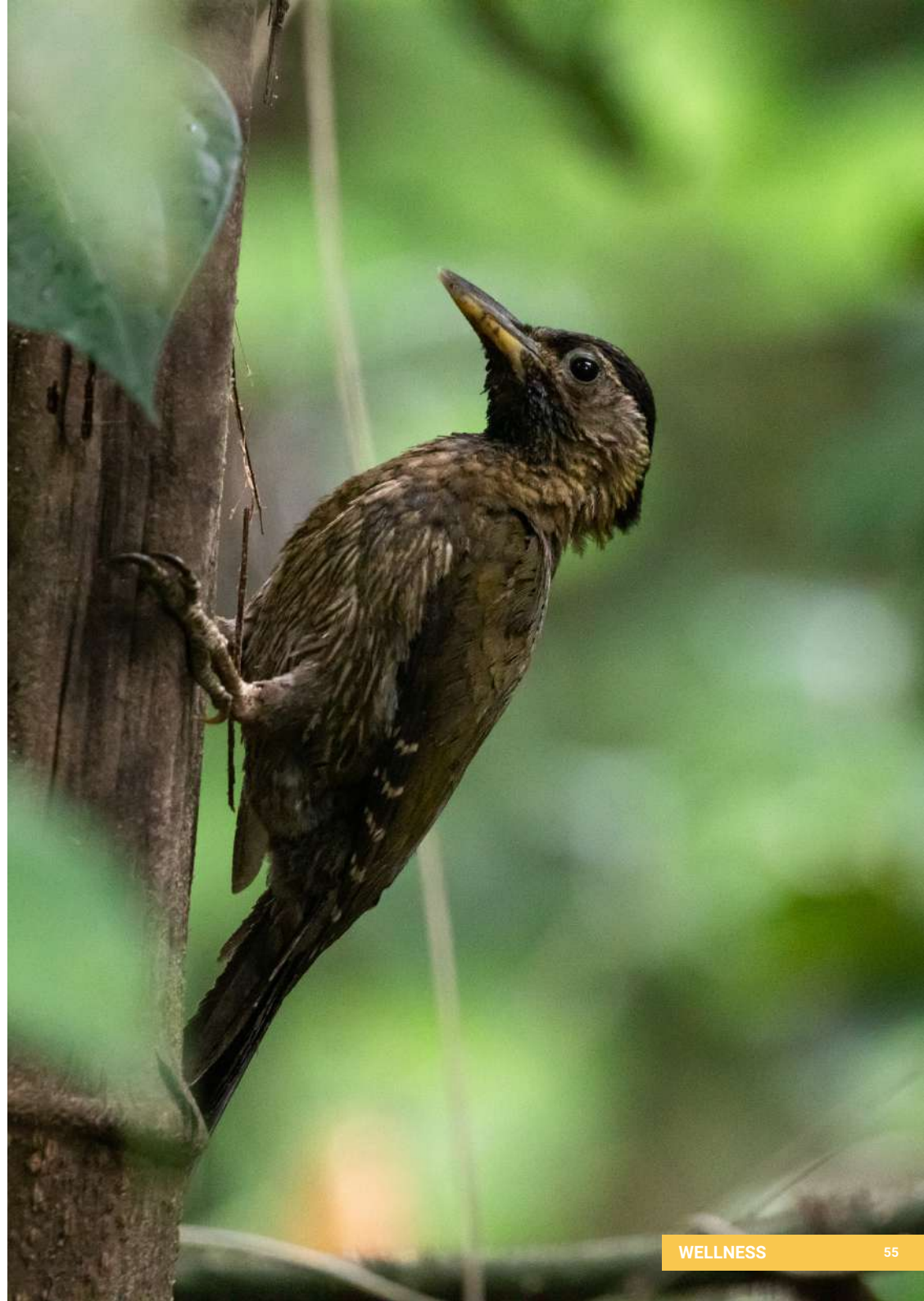
