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


# Recently published in Aesthetic Plastic Surgery...

#### Cheeklift With and Without Posterior Lamellar Spacer Grafts for Treatment of Lower Eyelid Retraction

Compare outcomes of lower eyelid retraction repair using a subperiosteal midface lifting technique with and without posterior lamellar grafts.



Representative schematic demonstrating measurements taken from preoperative and postoperative patient photographs. Corneal diameter was measured as the distance between the borders of the corneal limbus. MRD2 (marginal reflex distance) was measured from the pupil center to the lower lid margin. MRD2limbus was measured from the lateral limbus at midpupillary line to the lower margin.



# Bio SCIENCE

### Synthetic Fillers: A Growing Trend and the Importance of Safe Practices

Today's lifestyle reflects immediacy in almost all aspects. Young generations are growing up in the shadow of immediate answers due to technological advancements and the demands of modern life. Aesthetics is no exception to this rule, therefore, a visible increase in non-surgical procedures, according to the statistics in our Global Survey1, is a consequence.

Among non-surgical procedures, fillers are the second most demanded treatment, only after botulinum toxin injections. The minimal downtime and immediate visible effects after the injection are some of the reasons for the consistent, continuous, and progressive growth of synthetic filler injections. It is an evolving market full of new products and trends.

At the same time, the widespread availability of fillers to a broad spectrum of practitioners has led to an increase in complications. It is important to shed light on the three factors that contribute to these complications: the products, the treatment, and the patient selection and follow-up. Therefore, a review of our current practices is advisable.

Back to the basics:

### **Product Selection**

Synthetic fillers have intrinsic physicochemical properties that make each one suitable for specific situations; knowing the pharmacological and rheological properties of the products is mandatory for modern and safe implantation. The appropriate product will provide the desired effect with the least amount possible while not triggering an immune response. Among the many synthetic fillers available, Hyaluronic Acid (HA) stands out for its high safety standards, making it the gold standard. Among all the HA products on the market, it is up to the doctor to select the most reliable and those with the highest safety records.

### Location "Injection Site"

After studying the patient and detailing the advantages and disadvantages of the proposed treatment, the future location of the injectable must be determined. The right location will offer the best possible result with fewer side effects and less volume. Precise knowledge of anatomy, as

well as local landmarks, will guide our needle or cannula to the desired position.

### Injection Technique

Implanting any device, even injectables requires time and caution. Avoid rushing, and carefully examine the patient's skin at the injection site and in the neighboring areas, as vascular complications can often occur in distant areas.

An important requirement is to avoid contamination and/or biofilm formation through proper technical management. During the injection process, the skin barrier will be breached with the needle, and since we are delivering an implant that requires tissue integration, adequate cleaning and sterile technique are mandatory. The presence of active inflammatory skin lesions must serve as a warning, and treatment should be postponed until the situation is fully resolved and the skin is healthy.

### Patient

Provide your patients with full access to you and your staff, and do not minimize the importance of phone calls or text messages, as timely communication is crucial for preventing harm. Educate your patients about what to expect and encourage them to follow our recommendations for better results, and to call if they have any doubts. Great outcomes are in the details.


# Going back to your personal background, can you elaborate on your journey, transitioning from Medical Career to Business, and a bit on your personal life?
